	WOODS Area covered by various types and ages of trees		OPEN LAWN Grassy area, few trees and purposeful planting
	OPEN WOODLAND Grassy area with few large trees		RIVER/STREAM Running water with riparian zone
	GRASSLAND Taller grasses and shrubs, few or no trees		LAKE/POND A lake or pond, including its riparian zone
			GRAY SPACES Build areas: buildings, parking lots, etc...
